

Useful Information for Members of the Media (Accreditation)

Media passes:

- The media pass provides access to the 2019 Bagotville International Air Show (SAIB 2019) site, a designated parking area, the Media Centre, photo area and other areas strictly reserved for media use, during event hours, **beginning the morning of Friday, June 21**. (On Friday, as the site is not yet officially open, **you will need to have your pass and report to the media tent when you arrive** so you can be assigned a Wing member as an escort).
- The pass is also required for media events occurring at the site the week before SAIB 2019.
- We will send you **one media pass for each person** registered. Passes are issued EXCLUSIVELY TO EMPLOYEES of recognized media outlets or agencies.* (**Employee spouses or children are not allowed in areas reserved for the media**). AN APPLICATION FORM WITH PHOTO IS REQUIRED FOR EACH EMPLOYEE (see "Media Accreditation SAIB 2019" form for details).
- Each **card displays the name and photo of the pass holder**. The pass holder must be able to **provide their media credentials** at all times upon request by a member of our security or site access team.

Parking pass:

- The parking pass provides access to the media parking area during SAIB 2019 **beginning the morning of Friday, June 21**. The pass must be **displayed in full view in the vehicle at all times**. It will be sent to you at the same time as the media pass.

Access route:

- **Enter through the Base's main gate** and follow directions to your parking area.

Media Centre:

- **Access to the Media Centre is restricted to media pass holders.**

- The SAIB 2019 Media Centre will be operational as of the **morning of Friday, June 21. A detailed schedule of the hours of operation will be sent to you the week of June 10.**
- The following will be available to members of the media at the Media Centre: telephones, faxes, **wired internet access** (bring an internet cable).
- The Media Centre is located **next to the runway and has a gallery** for watching the air demonstrations that is reserved for members of the media.

**Given the limited number of spots in the Media Centre, the Communications team reserves the right to restrict the number of authorized members for each media outlet. The assignment manager or news director will be contacted if there are problems to discuss the best way forward. Issuing media passes to freelancers will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. The Communications team will contact the person in question for more information.*
